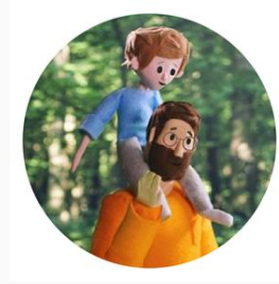
There are so many brilliant dads. Foster dads, adoptive dads, birth dads, plus amazing grandads, uncles and other relatives who care full-time for the children in their family.
